
A full-service mentoring program designed for family child care providers in Alabama

What are the provider benefits?

- * Regularly scheduled mentor visits in your home to provide hands-on training and technical assistance based on your individual needs

- * Training hours for licensing requirements
- * Opportunities to receive scholarships and equipment

What are the provider responsibilities?

- * Agree to have a mentor in your home for 3-5 hours per week at pre-arranged times
- * Completion of periodic assessments of your family child care home
- * Completion of child care questionnaires and telephone interviews with FCCP staff
- * Desire to improve the quality of care being offered in the home
- * Evaluation of your mentor's work and the FCCP program (via phone)
